GUIDANCE ON STUDENTS ENROLLED ON DISTANCE LEARNING

- 1. A meeting was held between Team University and National Council for Higher Education on Monday 17th April 2023 and agreed on the way forward.
- 2.(i) All facilities originally opened to facilitate Distance Learning are closed. Whoever operates them does so illegally and strict measures will be taken as by law established. The District Education Officers and RDC's/RCCs are informed accordingly.
 - ii) All students on Distance Learning are to be integrated on Open Distance and e-Learning (ODEL) through the office of the Academic Registrar.
 - iii) All examinations are to be conducted at Team University Campus.
- 3.Team University has applied for accreditation of branches at Mbale, Iganga, Rukungiri, Hoima, Ntungamo, Fortportal and Lira. NCHE is processing the applications. Until these branches are accredited, no admission or teaching is allowed at the space facilities. What is allowed is establishment of infrastructure in readiness for accreditation.
